- **041.1** Car boot sales to consider reaffirming that Saturday car boot sales can continue in Bedale Park as planned
- **041.2** Calvert Way play area to note that the transfer of this land to the Town Council has still not occurred due to an ongoing minor legal issue between Persimmon Homes and the land's previous owner.

046 Grass cutting

- **046.1** To consider varying the grounds maintenance contract so that the town's large grassed areas Bedale Park, Wycar Green, Southfields and Burrill Road are cut fortnightly between May-September, rather than three-weekly as at present.
- **046.2** To appoint a working group of three Councillors plus the Clerk to draw up the tender document for grass cutting from April 2022 March 2025, consider tenders received, and recommend an appointment to the Council

047 Christmas issues

- **047.1** To consider applying for a road closure and parking suspension on Market Place from Bridge Street to Emgate between 6am-6pm on Saturday 27th November, at a cost not exceeding £1,000 including traffic management and licensing fees.
- **047.2** To consider changing the timing of Santa's arrival and the Christmas Lights switch-on to 4.30pm, as a road closure would remove any traffic issues.
- **047.3** To consider purchasing around 20 artificial or artistic Christmas trees to be fitted in the brackets above shop doors on North End / Market Place, at a cost not exceeding £1,000
- **048 Platinum Jubilee beacon** to consider whether, and if so how, to take part in the Queen's Platinum Jubilee beacon lighting at 9.15pm on Thursday 2nd June 2022, and the preceding piping of *Diu Regnare*
- 049 Bedale Park toilets to formally approve expenditure of £930 to install an improved flush system to the toilets, allowing a full instant flush and therefore allowing the toilets to manage the traffic of a busy car boot sale morning
