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- 22.20 Planning matters** – to consider planning applications including:  
22/00376/LBC, listed building consent for painting external windows and door, and internal walls and ceilings, at 18 Market Place;  
and 22/00985/FUL for a detached building containing three additional classrooms at Mowbray School, Masham Road;  
Also to note planning decisions made by principal authorities since March’s meeting, and to receive notification of two “permitted development” caravan rallies
- 22.21 Bedale Youth Council** – to consider supporting this new initiative by funding the cost of their hosting monthly meetings in Bedale Hall, at a cost of not more than £180
- 22.22 Bedale Beck** – to note the condition of Bedale Beck, with issues including encroaching vegetation (iris/willow) and silt, and poor water quality, and to consider approaching the Environment Agency to advocate for a thorough overhaul of the Beck downstream of the B6268 bridge
