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- **Planning matters** to consider planning applications including: ZB23/00816/FUL for change of use from retail to a domestic extension of the neighbouring property, at 14 South End; 23/00
  - Also to note planning decisions made by principal authorities since April's meeting
- 23.20 Beckside to note that the wooden banking immediately upstream of the Harbour and weir at Bedale Beck is degraded and inadequate, and to note that Coxon Bros and Salix Ltd have been engaged to offer potential solutions and prices for what will be extremely expensive work
- 23.21 Memorial bench to consider a request from the Bedale and RAF Leeming branch of the Royal Air Force Association to fund the installation and initial upkeep of a bench by Bedale Beck in memory of Warrant Officer Kevin Hamilton-Sturdy, who sadly and prematurely died last year
