

## BEDALE CHRISTMAS MARKET 2024

The Christmas Market is part of a full day's festive celebrations, including children's fairground rides, music all day from a stage by the Market Cross, and the town Christmas Lights switch-on. The Market Place will be closed to traffic for the day between the Bridge Street junction and the Market Cross.

Where: **Bedale Market Place**  
When: **Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> December**  
Set up: **By 10am**  
Take down: **After the Xmas Lights switch-on  
(which is at 4.30pm)**



### Information for Traders

Fee: **£25** for up to 5m frontage – price on application for larger stalls

All traders are required to:

- Supply, erect and dismantle their own stalls.
- Provide any lighting required for their stalls
- Have their own Public Liability Insurance of at least £5m
- Keep their site clean and tidy and to remove litter and waste materials on leaving

Traders may use **generators** but must ensure that they have read and comply with the published regulations concerning their use.

Traders wishing to sell **food** should hold a food hygiene certificate and comply with all regulations.

Traders wishing to sell **alcoholic beverages** must inform the Council on booking. The Council will obtain a Temporary Event Notice to cover all alcohol sales on the Market.
