- 24.63** **Beckside Path** – to consider commissioning work to underpin the wooden footway on Bedale Beck (between Harbour Rise and Brookside Avenue) with heavy-duty gabions, at a cost of £22,903. In the interests of making the path safe before the winter, this would be taken from reserves and funded by a one-off additional levy on the 2025-26 precept
- 24.64** **Tree work** – to consider commissioning the removal of three dead/dying hawthorn bushes at Southfields public open space, at a cost of £385
