- 25.44 Activity infrastructure in Bedale Park to consider approving investigations into the feasibility / cost of an "active track" around the perimeter of Bedale Park, and a "pump track" for younger children to learn/improve cycle skills at the west side of the Park between the track and the Golf Club boundary; these facilities to be funded externally, with the Council assuming management and maintenance responsibility on installation
- **25.45 Computers** to consider the purchase of new desktop and laptop computers for the Town Council office, given the age of the existing units (6 and 8+ years respectively) and that neither machine is compatible with Windows 11, at a cost not exceeding £1,500
